

## **Setting Up DC305 to Calculate Days in Far Off and Close Up Pens**

1. Create new item DIFO (days in far off dry pen)
  - a. Go to the FILE menu, Select **Alter**.
  - b. Select **Number 2 – Items**.
  - c. Select **Number 4 – Add an Item Definition**
  - d. Fill in the fields as follows:
    - In Abbrv: type **DIFO**
    - In Item type: select **1**
    - In Description: type **number of days in far off dry**
  
2. Create new item DICU (days in close up pen)
  - a. Go to the FILE menu, Select **Alter**.
  - b. Select **Number 2 – Items**.
  - c. Select **Number 4 – Add an Item Definition**
  - d. Fill in the fields as follows:
    - In Abbrv: type **DICU**
    - In Item type: select **1**
    - In Description: type **number of days in close up**
  
3. Create new item PFPEN (date moved to close up pen)
  - a. Go to the FILE menu, Select **Alter**.
  - b. Select **Number 2 – Items**.
  - c. Select **Number 4 – Add an Item Definition**
  - d. Fill in the fields as follows:
    - In Abbrv: type **PFPEN**
    - In Item type: select **18**
    - In Description: type **date moved to close up pen**

4. Create new command PREFRES
  - a. Go to the FILE menu, Select **Alter**.
  - b. Select **Number 3 – Commands**
  - c. Select **Number 4 – Add a Command**
  - d. Fill in the fields as follows:

5. Change the Fresh command to begin calculating days in close up.
  - a. Go to the File menu, Select **Alter**
  - b. Select **Number 3 - Commands**
  - c. Select **Number 5 - Exam/Modify a Command**
  - d. Double Left Click on the **FRESH** command
  - e. Left click on the **Content line**, add **!DICU=FDAT-PFPEN FOR DICU=0 FDAT>PFPEN PFPEN>0** to the end of the command

6. Change the DRY command to clear DIFO, DICU, and PFPEN
  - a. Go to the File menu, Select **Alter**

  - c. Select **Number 5 - Exam/Modify a Command**
  - d. Double Left Click on the **DRY** command
  - e. Left click on the **Content line**, add **DIFO=0 DICU=0 PFPEN=0**
